BETTER WATER FOR AUTUMN HILLS RESIDENTS

Residents of Autumn Hills Mobile Home Park, located off Highway OO just west of Old Monroe are now receiving better drinking water, compliments of Public Water Supply District #1 of Lincoln County.

The District recently acquired the Autumn Hills water system from receivership and immediately took steps to flush and disinfect the water lines formerly owned and controlled by the previous park owner.

Once the flushing and disinfection of the water lines was complete, the District and Alliance Water Resources, collected and tested the water lines to assure the Autumn Hills water system could be connected and tied into the District's water system along Highway C. Once the connection was made, water system officials removed and disconnected the old Autumn Hills water wells from service so they could no longer provide water.

Autumn Hills residents now receive good, clean drinking water regulated by the District and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. The water is cleaner, meets regulatory drinking water standards and is at a higher, more constant water pressure than ever before.

During the next few weeks, the District and Alliance will be installing water meters at all homes within the park. The District will send each resident their own monthly bill for the amount of water used the previous month. The District estimates the average monthly bill will range from \$26 to \$35 per month depending on each customers actual water use.

The District provides emergency service 24/7. The District's office is located at 3451 South Highway W, Winfield, Missouri and is open from 8am to 4:30pm Monday through Friday. The District accepts checks, credit card and on-line payments. Customers can view their account information at the District's website www.lincolncountywater.com.
